- 1. LIANG Ch'ang*, Macao representative of the Chinese Communist Political Bureau's Hong Kong branch, who, together with P. J. Lobo**, chief of the Economic Bureau in the Macao Government, monopolizes the rice market and [REDACTED] is in frequent contact with the Chinese Communist government and supplies the Chinese Communists with coal, gasoline, Diesel oil, engines, and machine parts.

- 2. The trans-shipment of these supplies through Macao to Canton is in the hands of CHOU Yu (周有), president of the Lei Hong (不航) Company and Chairman of the Macao Shipping Industry Association. Several shipments of gasoline and airplane parts have already been sent to Canton by this means.
