1. A train of 37 flatcars loaded with aircraft parts, including fuselages, wings, etc., passed through the Oranienburg (N 53/Z 67) railroad station on 11 December 1949. The shipment coming from the Soviet Union via Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63) was for the air force unit [] in Oranienburg.

2. A similar train from the Soviet Union [] [] passed through the Oranienburg railroad station on 3 January 1949.
