b. Two boxcars were loaded with boxes and furniture, four boxcars were sealed and 10 boxcars were empty but equipped with wooden benches.

4. Leaving brest and arriving at Frankfurt/Oder about 3 January 1950:

A train of 6 coaches, 4 boxcars, and 12 gondola cars, heading toward lest, was seen near Warsaw. Each gondola car carried a canvas-covered, long-barreled gun and a caterpillar tractor, or truck or passenger car. Four to six tractors, four to six trucks, and two passenger cars were seen on the train.

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## Corment:

Presumably a shipment of recruits arriving behind schedule or of specialists. Lost of the fall recruits (inducted during the Lummer of 1949) reached units in the Soviet Zone of Germany up to late Movember 1949.

Chipment of motor vehicles and guns enroute from the Soviet Union to the Soviet Zone of Germany.

Personnel going on furlough or to be discharged and dependents bound for the soviet Union.

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
