1. The Neuhardenberg (M 53/V 46) airfield was unoccupied on 12 February 1950. No reconditioning work was being done.
2. On 10 February 1950 it was observed that branch offices of the Maerkische Landbau and Brandenburgische Landbau Firms were established in Seelow (O 53/V 55). Both firms worked on construction of new farmhouses and roads. No information on the presence of other construction firms or indications of material shipments for the construction of airfields could be obtained from local residents.
3. A small infantry detail and an MVD headquarters were stationed in Seelow.
