1. No aircraft or flying was observed at the Wittstock (N 54/U 11) airfield on 18 and 19 December 1949. The three hangars on the southern edge of the field were closed. A surveying detail equipped with poles and theodolites was working on the east edge of the field. Workers were engaged in cutting the young trees east of the landing field. According to one of the workers, the field was to be expanded in this direction although the terrain was muddy. A cantonment building with a radio mast at its side stood on both the north and south edges of the field. The two radio trucks with presumed radar antenna which were previously observed on the north edge of the field were no longer there. The billets area south of the field was surrounded by a board fence about 2 1/2-meters high.

heavy truck traffic between the field and town in the evening. Forty-six trucks, most with \_\_\_\_\_ were counted between 5:45 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

4. In mid-December 1949 local residents said that the field was to be expanded in 1950 in the direction of Berlinchen (N 54/U 22).
5. Some Randow (N 54/U 11) farmers had to give part of their land to the Wittstock airfield for the construction of runways in late December 1949.
