The following information was obtained in Finow (N 53/V 08) in early January and on 2 February 1950:

25X1 [REDACTED]  
1. a. Former Messing-Altwerk:  
Occupied by about 150 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets. Allegedly a repair shop. Tanks and guns were towed to the plant.  
b. Former Messingwerk (administration building):  
Occupied by about 100 EM and a number of officers.

25X1C 2. a. Cantonment on Liesenthalerstrasse [REDACTED]  
Occupied by about 200 troops of a motor transport unit, referred to as motor pool, commanded by 1st Lt Davidov \*\*

25X1C b. Twenty-three trucks and six passenger cars were observed in front of, and in, the garages. [REDACTED]

25X1C 3. Another cantonment was observed on the road to Liesenthal, about 7 km SW of Finow. [REDACTED] The approach road was blocked by a guarded turnpike.\*\*\*
