50X1-HUM

1. The Danzig-Langfuhr (Q 55/Y 43) airfield was used only by Soviets. They constructed three runways.
2. Cantonment buildings for the flying and ground personnel were being constructed near the field. Many cables were hauled to the field.
3. About 2,000 young Polish workers of the Sluzba Polszoe Organizacji have been constructing hangars since July 1948. They have been quartered in tents near the field.
4. Twin-engine bombers of Soviet make were parked at the field.
