The following aircraft were parked at the field: On the eastern edge: 11 jet air craft and 1 monoplane, probably also a jet plane. On the northeastern edge: 7 jet aircraft facing west. On the northern edge of the debris site: 15 to 20 large fighters, 25 to 30 small fighters forther to the west, 8 biplanes and 18 jet aircraft. Near the flight control station: 3 or 4 twin-engine transports. 2. A stationary radio and DF station was east of the field (see Annex). German workers were doing clearing and improvement work on the cantonment buildings north of the The rader sets, previously seen near the Finowfurt (N 53/Z 98) estate, were not set up. 
