No Soviet soldiers were seen at the Barth airfield or in Barth (N 55/P 25). The field had an intact concrete runway. Warning signs set up by the county kommandatura indicated that the airfield was off limits.

That no changes have occurred at the airfield was shown by a comparison observations of December 1949. A Soviet Air Force unit is not assumed to be stationed in Barth.
