1. The Preparatory Committee for the Convocation of the All-China Conference of Writers and Artists (中華全國文學藝術工作者代表大會) was first formed at the end of March 1949, with the election of members from among the board of directors of the All-China Association of Literary and Art Workers (中華全國文藝協會). This organization was founded in Shanghai and had branches throughout the areas still controlled by Nationalist forces, in which it served as a Communist front and leftist nucleus. The association in the Communist-controlled areas was called the North China Association of Literary and Art Workers, with headquarters in Peiping and active branches known as the North China, Northeast China, Northwest China, East China, and Central Plain Associations.
2. Between March and June 1949 the number of the Preparatory Committee was increased to over forty by the addition of directors from the North China Association branches and some literary and art workers from the People's Liberation Army. Leading members of the Preparatory Committee are the following:

Chairman: KUO Mo-jo (郭沫若).

Deputy Chairmen: MAO Tun (茅盾) and CHOU Yang (周揚)。

4. Delegates to the All-China Conference consisted of those selected by reason of their positions in the All-China Association of Literary and Art workers and those selected because of special qualifications. In the first group were members and alternate members of the boards of directors of the branches of the All-China Association of Literary and Art Workers (including that part known as the North China Association of Literary and Art Workers) and its supervisors and deputy supervisors in the main and branch headquarters. In the second group were persons invited by the Preparatory Committee or by any one of the branches of the All-China Association, and persons suggested by local literary, art, political, and military organizations and approved by the Preparatory Committee. Qualifications included the following:

- a. Responsible or leading position in any high-level literary and art organization, any municipality, or any army corps in Communist areas.
  - b. Ten years of literary or art work, with a definite contribution to the revolutionary movement.
  - c. Advocacy of progressive ideas and conspicuous accomplishment in literature and art.
5. The Standing Committee selected the leading personnel for each delegation to the conference and grouped them into ten major divisions. These, with their chiefs, and deputy chiefs, included the following:
- a. Peiping-Tientsin First Delegation: Chief, LI Po-chao; deputies, CHOU Wei-chih, HO Lu-t'ing, and KUANG Wei-jan (光未然).
  - b. Peiping-Tientsin Second Delegation: Chief, TS'AO Ching-hua; deputy, FENG Chih.
  - c. North China Delegation: Chief, HSIAO San; deputies, T'LEN Chien and KAO Mu-hung (高沐鴻).
  - d. Northeast Delegation: Chief, LIU Chih-ming (劉芝明); deputies, LU Chi and SAI K'o (塞克).
  - e. Northwest Delegation: Chief, K'o Chung-p'ing; deputies, CHOU Wen (周文) and MA Chien-ling (馬健翎).
  - f. Central China Delegation: Chief, LU Wan-mei (陸萬美); deputies, CHANG Ling-ch'ing (張凌青) and FENG I-chih (馮毅之).
  - g. East China Delegation: Chief, HEI Ting (黑丁).
  - h. Southern (including South China and Hong Kong) First Delegation: Chief, OU-YANG Yu-ch'ien; deputies, T'LEN Han and FENG Nai-ch'ao.
  - i. Southern Second Delegation: Chief, FENG Hsueh-feng (馮雪峯); deputy, CH'EN Po-ch'en (陳伯塵).
  - j. Army Delegation: Chief, CHANG Chih-hsiang (張致祥); deputy, LAI Shao-ch'i (賴少其).
6. At the last meeting of the Standing Committee before the opening session of the All-China Conference, it was assumed that the chairman and vice-chairmen of the Preparatory Committee would become automatically chairman and vice-chairmen of the All-China Conference. Officials appointed in addition to these were SHA K'o-fu as secretary general of the Conference and HUANG Yao-mien (黃藥眠), CH'EN I-lin (陳以霖), and SHEN T'uan (沈團) as his assistants.
7. The preparatory session of the Conference occurred on 30 June 1949, with 650 of the 753 chosen delegates in attendance. The session immediately formed a presidium of ninety members in addition to the chief, KUO Mo-jo, and the two deputy chiefs, MAO Tun and CHOU Yang. Members of the Presidium were:

8. The opening session of the Conference took place in Peiping on 2 July 1949, with more than six hundred delegates attending. Among the important guests were CHU Te, LIN Po-ch'ü (林伯渠), TUNG Pi-wu (董必武), LU Ting-i (陸定一), LI Wei-han (李維漢), LI Chi-shen, SHEN Chun-ju (沈鈞儒), T'IEH Chien-ying, P'ENG Tse-min (彭澤民), TS'AI T'ing-k'ai (蔡廷鍇), CHU Hsueh-fan (朱學範), LI Hsiu-chen (李秀真), LI Te-ch'üan (李德全), and CH'IEH Chun-ju (錢俊瑞). KUO Mo-jo presided and gave the opening address, followed by a report from MAO Tun on the preparatory work for the conference and from FENG Nai-ch'ao on the examination of qualifications for delegates. CHU Te spoke on the connection between the leftist literary and art movements and the revolution and the use of literature and art as a stimulus towards reconstruction. Speeches were made by TUNG Pi-wu as representative of the North China People's Government and the Chinese Communist Party's Central Committee's North China Politburo and LI Hsiu-chen as representative of the North China peasants. Most of the leading guests made speeches on suitable topics. The meeting was concluded by the presentation of a banner by LI Chien (李健), delegate of the North China Military Zone.

9. In connection with the opening session, the first of four days' music recitals was given by performers from all parts of China. An art exhibition was also opened, accompanied by a display of literary material from progressive writers.
10. At the second session on 3 July, 576 delegates attended, with TING Ling presiding. KUO Mo-jo made a general report on the progress of the literary and artistic movement and two labor representatives, HSU Shih-jung (徐士榮), women employee of the army uniform factory, and LI Chia-chung (李家忠), employee of the 70 Arsenal, requested the help of writers and artists in interesting workers. The meeting closed with the reading of a poem by K'O Chung-p'ing "Turning the Nation into an Industrial State", and a rising vote of respect to artists who had undergone hardships under the Nationalist regime.
11. At the third session on 4 July, T' IEN Han presided and MAO Tun spoke about the past activities and future potentialities of writers and artists in Nationalist areas. He urged literary and art workers to improve their contribution to cultural reconstruction of the new China. At the fourth session on the following day, LI Po-chao acted as chairman and CHOU Yang reported on literary and art work in the Communist areas and the concentration of attention to art and literature by the workers, peasants, and soldiers. He urged greater participation by all classes in cultural activities. At the fifth session on 6 July, MAO Tse-tung acted as chairman and CHOU En-lai spoke on military and political advances in China.
12. The two succeeding days were devoted to small group discussions. General sessions were resumed on 9 July with SHA K'o-fu presiding. Speeches by playwright YANG Han-sheng, poet K'O Chung-p'ing, and writer TING Ling were issued in oral and written form preceding the main address by CH'EN Po-ta (陳伯達), deputy director of the Publicity Department of the CCP Central Committee, emphasizing the direction of thought along Marxist-Leninist channels and attention to the works of MAO Tse-tung, which combined these theories with practical background. The session concluded with the reading of a telegram of greetings from Fadeyev and Simonov, Soviet writers, and the playing of the Internationale.
13. The seventh and eighth sessions, on 10 and 11 July, presided over by CHOU Yang and HUNG Shen, respectively, stressed the application of literary and art endeavors to Communist themes, the reformation of various arts along those lines, and the valiant struggle of cultural workers against the Nationalist domination. Speakers included, on 10 July, CHAO Shu-li, LIU Chih-ming, LAI Shao-ch'i, PI Hua-fei (畢華飛), CHENG Chen-to, CH'EN Wang-tao, MEI Lan-fang, CHOU Hsin-fang (周信芳), TUNG T'ien-min, WANG Ts'ung-wen (王聰文), TS'AI Ch'u-sheng, and TAI Ai-lien, and on 11 July, CH'EN Hsueh-chao, TS'AO Yü, YANG Hui, SHIH Le-meng (時樂濤), WANG Tzu-k'o, CHUNG Ching-wen, LIEN K'uo-ju (連闊如), and MA Ssu-ts'ung. WANG Hsiang (王祥) and LI Ang (李昂), two delegates to the All-China Railway Workers' Provisional Conference, which was then in session, expressed a wish for cultural aid in reconstruction of the nation's railways, and CH' IEN Chün-jui inveighed against the influence of imperialism on Chinese culture.
14. At the ninth session on 12 July, K'O Chung-p'ing was chairman and HSIAO San spoke on the one hundred fiftieth anniversary of Pushkin; FU Chung (傅鍾), assistant director of the Political Department of the People's Liberation Army reported on literary and art work in the army. The session concluded with the presentation of banners by CH'OE Pong for the Koreans and YUNG Fu (勇夫) for the Inner Mongolian Corps of Literary and Art Workers.

15. The tenth session on 14 July was devoted to the formation of a federation of organizations represented at the conference. The federation is to be called the All-China Federation of Writers and Artists. Draft regulations for the federation and measures for election of its central committee were adopted. It was followed by a cocktail party for all the delegates, given by the North China Politburo, government, and military control commission, and the Peiping China Democratic League, Kuomintang Revolutionary Committee, and Workers' and Peasants' Democratic Party.
16. The conference concluded with a day-long discussion of candidates for the central committee on 15 July, elections on the 16 and 17 July, and a closing session on 19 July under the chairmanship of FENG Hsueh-feng. KUO Mo-jo summarized the accomplishments of the conference, and the members of the Central Committee of the All-China Federation of Literary and Art Workers (中華全國文學藝術界聯合會) were announced.
17. The committee was assigned ninety-five members, but eight seats were left vacant for writers and artists to be appointed from Nationalist areas. The eighty-seven announced members were:
