- 25X1 1. [redacted] delivery of 11 speed governors for water turbines manufactured by the Austrian Firm Voith in St. Poelten and the acceptance of these goods by the Soviet acceptance engineer Anichkin [redacted]
- 25X1 2. Engineer Chudov is the chief engineer of the Firm Voith.
- 25X1 [redacted] Comment:
- a. The reported firm chiefly produces large turbines and generators. Recently an engine lathe ("Drehwerk") was installed in the plant. It is the largest of its kind in Europe and cost 4 million schillings to build. Works of up to 15 m in diameter and 5 m in height can be turned on this giant lathe. Thus the weight of the work pieces is not limited.
- b. The exact address of the plant is 40 Pascauerstrasse in St. Poelten. It is assigned to the USIA (Upravlenie Sovetskogo Imushchestva Austrii) which has its headquarters at 11 Starhembergasse in Vienna IV.
