- In response to May Day proclamations issued in Peking, two organizations have been formed in Macao, both advocating the abolition of foreign control in Hong Kong, Kowloon and Macao. Since the two groups, acting independently, have been attempting to obtain a favored position with the Chinese Communist Party, friction has developed between them.*
 - One of these groups, the Macao Branch Commission for retaking Hong Kong, Kowloon and Macao, functions under the direction of the Chinese Communist special commissioner for Macao.** Members of the Overseas Chinese Association form the nucleus of this group. Its committee members include the following:
 - CH'EN Chih-sheng (陳直生),*** head of the Overseas Movement, a section of the South China Politburo's branch office in Macao.
 - FENG Chu-wan (馮祝萬)***
 - HSIEH Tsai-sheng (謝再生)
 - K'O Cheng-p'ing (柯正平), the head of the Culture and Education Section of the Macao office of South China Politburo.***
 - K'O Lin (柯麟), chief of the South China Politburo's branch office in Macao.***
 - LI Ming-hsin (李明欣)***
 - LIANG Chih-chih (梁秩智)
 - The other organization is the Macao Sub-Association for the Liberation of Hong Kong, Kowloon and Macao, which is under the direction of the New Democracy Association. Committee men are as follows:
 - CH'EN Kuo-chieh (陳國傑), one of the leaders of the New Democracy Association.

4. The South China Politburo has sent a twelve-man operational team trained in terrorist activities into Macao. The assassination of LO Kuang (羅光),**** former pro-Nationalist chief of the Canton Seamen's Union, on 7 May, and the bomb explosion in the Hua Chia Pao, pro-Nationalist newspaper, are indications of increased Communist activity in Macao.
