1. a. Forty-six boxcars loaded with uranium ore according to bill of lading and one boxcar occupied by escorting personnel (one officer and five soldiers wearing black epaulets), en route from Johannegeorgenstadt to Brest.

- b. A train carrying thirty T34 tanks and up stood at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station. It was headed toward Berlin. (1)

23 April 1950

2. A train of about 70 to 80 axles (mostly boxcars), carrying four prime movers and four guns of about 88 mm caliber stood at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station. It was headed toward Berlin. (2)

3. One boxcar loaded with ammunition boxes, escorted by two soldiers wearing red epaulets, en route from Ketschendorf to Hoegelin.
