Alte Kaserne on Alsenstrasse, Prenzlau (M 54/4 04)

1. Occupied to capacity by about 1,200 police ranging from 19 to 21 years of age.
2. Ten 30-man platoons, armed with carbines, marched into the barracks area the afternoon of [REDACTED] 1950. 25X1A
3. Three 30-man platoons, commanded by officers, marched into the barracks area on [REDACTED] They came from the direction of the airfield. The police in the last two ranks of each platoon carried barbed-wire reels and wooden crosses. 25X1A

Fliegerhorst Kaserne

4. Occupied by about 400 police. No training activity observed. VP personnel seen there seemed older and well-trained.
5. Three houses guarded by VP sentries were located on the western perimeter of the airfield, between the railroad line and the road. The headquarters of a VP unit seemed to be located in these houses.

Airfield area

6. VP units of 300 to 400 men, armed with carbines, were seen drilling the afternoon of [REDACTED] 25X1A
