- 1. No plants had delivered or received from the lest any shipments of light metals, rubber, rubberized textures, or belts, which might have been used in the production of gas masks. The rubberized textures produced or delivered were so thick that they could have been meant only for the manufacture of conveyor belts.
- 2. The Maltershausen (... 51/H 95) rubber hose weaving plant and rubber factory - a plant of the hesinotekhnika Loviet Corporation - received two lots, totaling 40 tons, of pressed sheet-metal articles, as well as crude rubber and cord weavings from the U.S.D.R., during January 1950. No detailed information was available on the use of these materials.
