1. A train of 47 tank cars containing gasoline left Frankfurt/Oder on 2 June 1950, reaching Brest Litovsk on 5 June 1950.

2. From 300 to 400 empty heavy-duty flatcars were observed at the Brest Litovsk railroad station on 5 June 1950.

25X1 3. A train carrying ammunition loaded on 27 freight cars and destined for [redacted] Buckau (M 53/D 69), and 12 heavy mortars for an unidentified unit in Schwerin left Brest Litovsk on 7 June 1950 and arrived in Frankfurt/Oder on 10 June 1950.

25X1 4. Four freight cars loaded with ammunition for [redacted] Stendal, and three freight cars of unidentified cargo for [redacted] Kaulsdorf (N 53/Z 95), were observed at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station on 10 June 1950. *
