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SUBJECT Eighth Anti-Communist Guerrilla Army, Kwangtung

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THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

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1. The 8 Anti-Communist Guerrilla Army, under Chang Tse-shen (張澤森), has about 10,000 men operating in Central Kwangtung. They are poorly equipped, inadequately trained for anything but guerrilla fighting, and under-supplied with ammunition, food, and medical aid.
2. This force recently lost 500 men and rifles in action against the Communist 4 Field Army at Yangchiang (111-53, 21-52) and Eng'ing (112-19, 22-12), but the main body of troops was not affected.
3. The designation, strength and location of each unit in this force are as follows:
