1. A train of 47 tank cars containing gasoline left Frankfurt/Oder on 22 June 1950, arriving at Brest-Litovsk on 26 June 1950. (1)
2. A west-bound train carrying 500 troops and 18 T-34 tanks was observed in Schwiebus (O 53/W 33) on 22 June 1950. (2)
3. About 300 empty railroad cars and a stock of about 8,000 tons of coal were at the Brest Litovsk railroad station prior to 27 June 1950. (3)
4. A train carrying ammunition loaded on 25 freight cars and consigned to Unit [REDACTED] in Buckau, 200 soldiers wearing black-bordered red epaulets, and 25 AT guns of about 100-mm for an unidentified unit in Jueterbog left Brest-Litovsk on 27 June 1950 and arrived in Frankfurt/Oder on 1 July 1950. (4) 25X1C
5. Four freight cars, carrying unidentified cargo for Unit [REDACTED] Stendal, and two freight cars loaded with ammunition for Unit [REDACTED] Doeberitz, were observed at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station on 1 July 1950. (4) 25X1C
6. No east-bound empty trains were observed in Frankfurt/Oder.

Comments.

- (1) Shipment of reparations goods
- (2) Presumably combined shipment of personnel and materiel from the U.S.S.R to the Soviet Zone of Germany, rather than an entire unit.
- (3) Five hundred to six hundred empty railroad cars were at Brest-[REDACTED]
- (4) Shipments of ammunition from the USSR. [REDACTED] confirms the Doeberitz Ho 1st Mecz Div prior to 1 July 1950; [REDACTED] belongs to a Buckau-Transdorf AF supply depot and [REDACTED] was previously observed with a Stendal unit receiving spare parts and ammunition.
