1. While driving to [REDACTED] (M 52/D 11), [REDACTED] stopped 25X1X by a Soviet sentry at the northern entrance to the town. While making detours, he hastily observed an airfield, which was unknown to date, north of the Stockhausen (M 52/D 11) - Sondershausen road, and about 1,200 meters south of hill 292. The field was occupied by an unknown number of single-engine low-wing monoplanes. *

- 25X1A * [REDACTED] Comment. First report that an airfield exists near Sondershausen. The area is not suitable for the construction of a large fighter airfield.
