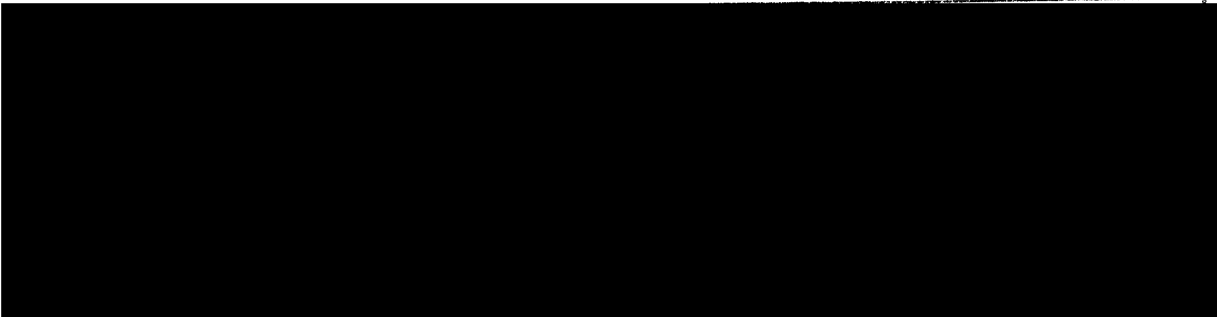

On 3 August 1950 a group of 24 Chinese students from Malaya, who had been taken into the Chinese Communist Party in late July 1950, arrived in Hong Kong on the SS KUEIYANG, Butterfield and Swire. The group was led by LO Shou-ch'un (駱壽春) and LO Ho-ch'i (駱何其), who stayed at the Chung Nan Trading Company, fourth floor, 26 Des Voeux Road West, while in Hong Kong.\* On 5 August 1950, the students sailed for Swatow on the SS KUEIYANG.\*\*

25X1A \* [REDACTED] Comment. SO-39999 mentioned a Chung Nan Company, Connaught Road, and SO-41120 reported a South China Trading Company. The street address is the same as that reported for the Chui Tak Loong Company in [REDACTED].

25X1A \*\* Washington comment. Similar delegations of students from Malaya and Indonesia have been reported in [REDACTED]. According to SO-45152 the students traveled from Singapore on the SS ANHUI, a Butterfield and Swire vessel which was sunk in June 1950.
