The following regiments were confirmed at the fields at which they had previously been known to be stationed: One fighter regiment each at Alt-Loennewitz, Dessau, Grossenhain, and Zerbst. 3. Soviet military personnel on furlough, mainly NCO's without arms, passed through the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station en route to Brest-Litovsk at the rate of about 380 men per day from 11 to 19 August, 1950.
