(1)Possibly artillery units which returned to their home stations from Altengrabow. A report on the arrival of a heavy artillery unit was received from Rurg on 15 June 1950. 50X1-HUM (2) The captive balloons observed in the Altengrahow area presumably belonged to an artillery recommaissance battalion of the 6th Arty Div. The division with numerous component artillory units held field training at the Altengrabow range. (3) The motor vehicles belonged to the following units, and thus indicate their location in Altengrabow up to the end of June 1950: The unidentified Gun Arty Brig, possibly the 10th, of the 6th Arty Div, or the 18th How Arty Brig, also of the 6th Arty Div. It is not known which of these series bolong to those two writs. The unidentified Light Arty Brig, possibly the 65th, of the 6th Arty Div. The unidentified RL Brig, possibly the 25th, of the IV Arty Corps. The unidentified Gun Arty Brig, possibly the Lith, of the Third Shock Army. 50X1-HUM The unidentified AT Arty Brig, possibly the 3rd, of the LXXIX Litz Rifle Corps. Unidentified AT Arty Brig, possibly the 4th, of the IV Arty Corps. Unidentified AAA Div, possibly the 32nd, of the GOFG, 50X1-HUM elements of which are permanently stationed in Alten-50X1-HUM 2nd Gds AAA Div, elements of which allogedly went to Altengrabow in late Harch and early April. They were probably only small clements or individual motor vehicles because component units of the division were observed on 8 July on the Justrow Peninsula, which can be considered the main training area of the division.
