- 25X1 1. The former Luftnachrichten Schule in Bernau appeared vacant on 16 July 1950. Guns previously seen on the yard behind the main gate were gone. Two make-shift garages which formerly housed 10 trucks each were vacant. A radio car constantly seen in the billeting area was no longer there. A radio car occupied by 20 soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets left the installation to carry the personnel to a swimming pool. \*
- 25X1 2. There was no activity at the Fliegerhorst. #: Numerous trucks previously observed there were not seen. Two trucks [redacted] were in front of the hangar, which was closed.
- 25X1 3. Only sentries wearing red-bordered black epaulets were seen at the division bakery where formerly there were eight field kitchens under a shed. No motor vehicles were seen in the motor vehicle repair shop. Only a sentry wearing red-bordered black epaulets was seen.
- 25X1 4. The former carrier pigeon station in Bernau was observed every night from 18 to 22 July 1950. The windows of all five temporary barracks were illuminated. The troops quartered there were estimated at 200 to 250 men. Soldiers were seen only participating in athletics. Forty to fifty trucks were seen in the area of the pigeon carrier station [redacted]

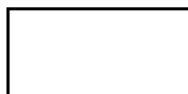
