THE FOLLOWING REPORT WAS PREVIOUSLY DISTRIBUTED AS CIA PRELIMINARY

1. At a conference in Peiping in early September attended by MAO Tse-tung, LIN Biao, CHU Te, NIEH Jung-chen, Mirbakov*, and other Soviet advisers, the following decisions were made:

- a. To attempt the peaceful settlement of the Tibet problem, either through the Indian Ambassador or by direct negotiations between Tibetan authorities and F'ENG Te-huai, Chairman of the Military and Administrative Committee of the Northeast region. A military offensive will be launched only as a last resort.
- b. To use Soviet influence in the Security Council of the United Nations to force the withdrawal of American support from the Chinese Nationalists. When this is achieved the invasion of Taiwan will be launched.
- c. To increase pressure on Hong Kong by a campaign of propaganda, increased labor unrest, and by military maneuvers on the frontier.

25X1A [REDACTED] Comment. The deputy chief of the Soviet mission to the Chinese Communist Government returned to Peiping from a tour of central and South China on 28 August to attend a military conference, scheduled for 1 September. See [REDACTED].
