1. [redacted] nine Japanese seamen and mechanics arrived at Macao from Hong Kong. They were held by the Macao police overnight, and then allowed to cross the Chinese border. The leader, SAITO Kyuichiro (齊藤 九一郎), held Peiping Government Entry Permit No. 339.
2. On 18 May, 24 Japanese airplane mechanics entered China through Macao. Their leader was OKADA Jusaburo (岡田 十三郎), who bore Peiping Government Entry Permit No. 763 and Kwangtung Military Control Commission Employment Document No. 268.
