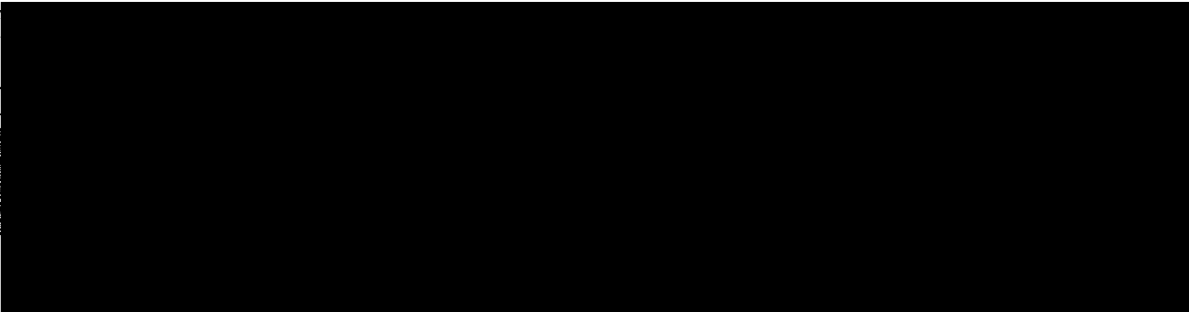

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. On 26 and 27 August 1950, an unusually large number of Soviet officers and enlisted men was observed at the railroad stations and related installations at Brest-Litovsk, but no Soviet troops were seen at Brest on 6 and 7 September.
2. In late August and early September 1950, about 3,000 Soviet tank and artillery troops had detrained in the Siedlce area (Poland).
