- 1. The Soviet Control Commission has requisitioned approximately ninety-five per cent of the total railway fuel tank cars available in the Russian Zone of Germany.
2. This figure includes tank cars to a capacity of about 100,000 tons which have been diverted to Böhlen-Espenhain where they are to be filled with aviation gasoline. They will then carry this fuel to Brest-Litovsk and will not return to the DDR.*

* Comment: The figure 100,000 tons may be an error for 10,000 tons. The movement of fuel from Böhlen to Brest-Litovsk seems more reasonable than the report stating that the tank cars were to proceed empty to Litovsk.
