Standing at the Eberswalde (N 53/V 08) railroad station at 10:30 a.m. on 18 July 1950 was a 60-axle train of tank cars, guarded by soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, and a train of 20 flatcars, loaded with aircraft crates and guarded by air force soldiers. Both trains were headed north. Switching personnel said that the trains were to leave for Finow (N 53/V 08). *

* Comment. The report has not been confirmed. It is possible that the crates contained jet planes for the Finow airfield.
