 - (2) Westbound - 25 flat cars of wood; 10 flat cars of coal; 2 flat cars of machinery and 12 flat cars of stone.
 - (3) Westbound - 21 flat cars of red dirt and 15 flat cars of stone.
 - (4) Eastbound - 4 flat cars of wood and 10 flat cars of assorted machinery.
Westbound - 41 flat cars of coal; 31 flat cars of wood; 35 flat cars of dirt and 10 flat cars of machinery.
 - (5) Westbound - 22 flat cars of stone; 6 flat cars of wood; 16 flat cars of coal and 5 flat cars of machinery.
 - (6) Eastbound - 5 flat cars of machinery.
Westbound - 24 flat cars of wood; 24 flat cars of coal; 1 flat car of jeeps and 5 flat cars of miscellaneous machinery.
 - (7) Westbound - 6 flat cars were loaded with coal.
