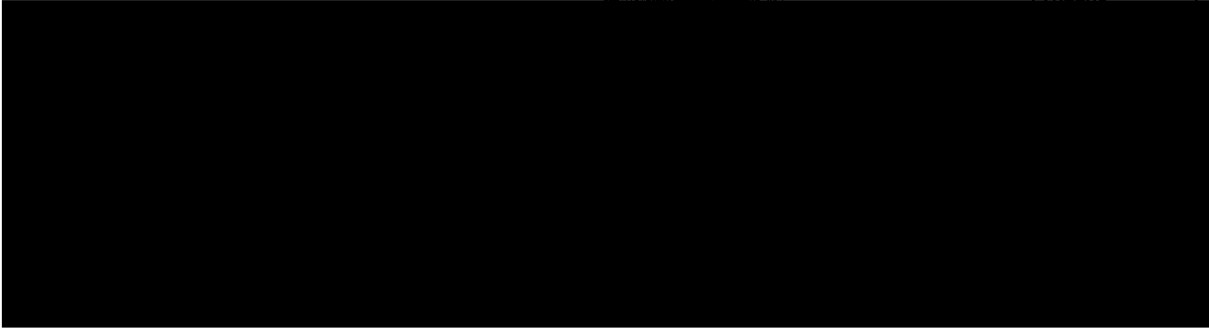

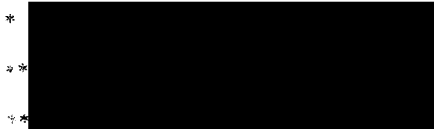

On 5 August 1950 HO Hsien\* received a letter from K'O Lin, who was in Peiping, in which K'O asked HO to relinquish his stock of gasoline, a total of 23,000 tins, to the Chinese Communists and to deliver it to the Hua Ta (華大) Company, operated by LA Wan-ch'i\*\*, for transportation to the mainland. In early August this stock of gasoline was stored in Number 9 Godown, Ch'ingchou (青洲), Macao, which was formerly the site of the Chen Hsing (振興) Rubber Factory.
2. In early August 1950 JUNG Ken (容根), manager of the Lei Hong Company\*\*\*, Macao, had agreed to undertake the purchase of 3,000 drums of gasoline and 500 pairs of tires for the Chungshan Military Control Commission.
3. CHOU Yu\*\*\* of the Lei Hong Company joined the Democratic League in Hong Kong. In early August 1950 he had concluded negotiations with the Chinese Communists in Canton whereby all ships of the Lei Hong Company were to be chartered for military transport service for the Chinese Communists.
