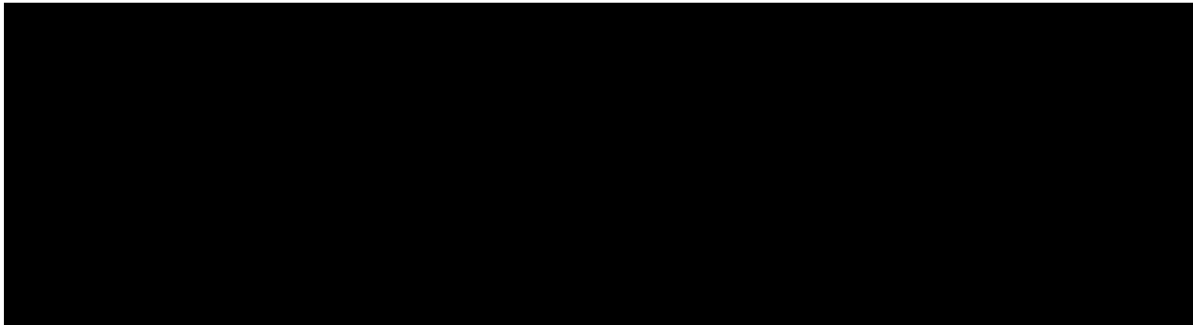

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. Between 26 September and 14 October 1950, 870 boxcars with recruits passed through Küstrin-Kietz and proceeded toward Herbig. Two hundred and seventy-two empty boxcars, east-bound, passed through Küstrin-Kietz between 8 and 14 October. 25X1X
2. On 10 October [REDACTED] a train carrying a unit of an unidentified AAA division of the Group of Soviet Occupation Forces on the Stralsund-Pasewalk-Bernau rail line.*
3. The following shipments passed through Frankfurt/Oder between 10 and 15 October:
 - a. 188 boxcars with troops, coming from Küstrin and proceeding toward Cottbus.
 - b. 14 boxcars with troops and 34 tanks, coming from Brest-Litovsk and proceeding toward Cottbus.
 - c. 67 rail-type rocket-launchers and 34 tanks, coming from Brest-Litovsk. The rocket-launchers were dispatched toward Dannenwalde and Jessen. The destination of the tanks was not determined.
 - d. 104 empty boxcars going toward Küstrin: 58 came from Magdeburg and 46 from Erfurt.
4. One troop train was observed en route to Loewenberg from Zehdenick. Vehicle [REDACTED] that the units were headquarters elements of the Fourth Guards Mechanized Army.
