1. [REDACTED] fighter regiment was observed in Lärz, which had been operating from Neuruppin on 10 October. A fighter regiment which had previously been located in Peenemünde was observed at Neubrandenburg. A reconnaissance regiment previously observed at Stendal was observed on 18 October in the Zerbst-Dessau area.
2. A fighter regiment from Alt-Lönnewitz was observed reconnoitering tank columns in the Jüterbog area.
3. The following additional units were confirmed:

One fighter regiment each at Lärz, Oranienburg, Neubrandenburg, Alt-Lönnewitz, Brandis, and Grossenhain.

A fighter division headquarters in Peenemünde.

One ground-attack regiment each in the following areas: Jüterbog or Reinsdorf; the area south of Weimar, Döberitz or Schönwalde, but observed operating near Plauen; the airfield at Schönwalde; and the area of Jena.

4. On 19 October the following units were confirmed:

One fighter regiment each at Alt-Lönnowitz, Dessau, Brandis, Lärz, Parchim, Finow, Oranienburg, Brandenburg, Zerbst, and Grossenhain.

One bomber regiment at Cottbus.

One ground-attack regiment in the Jüterbog area (not the one observed on the previous day in the area of Jüterbog-Reinsdorf).
