1. A train made up of 15 cold engines and 30 freight cars loaded with machinery, left Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63) on 14 September 1950 and arrived at Brest Litovsk (S 53/L 87) on 16 September 1950. It passed through Poznan (P 53/X 26) on 14 September, Kutno (Q 53/O 89) on 15 September and Siedlce (R 53/L 88) on 16 September 1950. *
2. A west-bound freight train carrying 6 JS-122 tanks, 8 150-mm guns and 10 trucks was observed in Neubentschen (O 53/W 53) on 14 September 1950. **
3. No Soviet troop concentrations were observed at Brest Litovsk or other railroad stations.
