1. Six SP guns, about 200 soldiers and four trucks were unloaded in Wolmirstedt on 25 August 1950. (1) One hundred ammunition boxes were piled beside the freight track at the Wolmirstedt railroad station. Trucks [redacted] were hauling away the ammunition. (2) 50X1-HUM

2. A shipment of 15 used trucks with numbers of the [redacted] and [redacted] series arrived in Frankfurt/Oder on 30 August 1950, coming from the direction of Poland. 50X1-HUM

3. One boxcar loaded with 30 crates containing grindstones was en route from Dresden-Reick to Muellrose on 1 September 1950. [redacted] (3) 50X1-HUM

4. Rail shipments observed at the Frankfurt/Oder freight yard between 29 August and 1 September 1950 included:

- On 7 September 1950 a train of eight boxcars occupied by soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulets, an undetermined number of flatcars carrying 11 guns of about 20 mm caliber, and 29 trucks passed through the Neubrandenburg railroad station. The train came from the direction of Guestrow and headed toward Neustrelitz. (5)
- No military shipments in either direction passed through the Kuestrin-Neustadt railroad station between 13 August and 5 September 1950.

Comments.

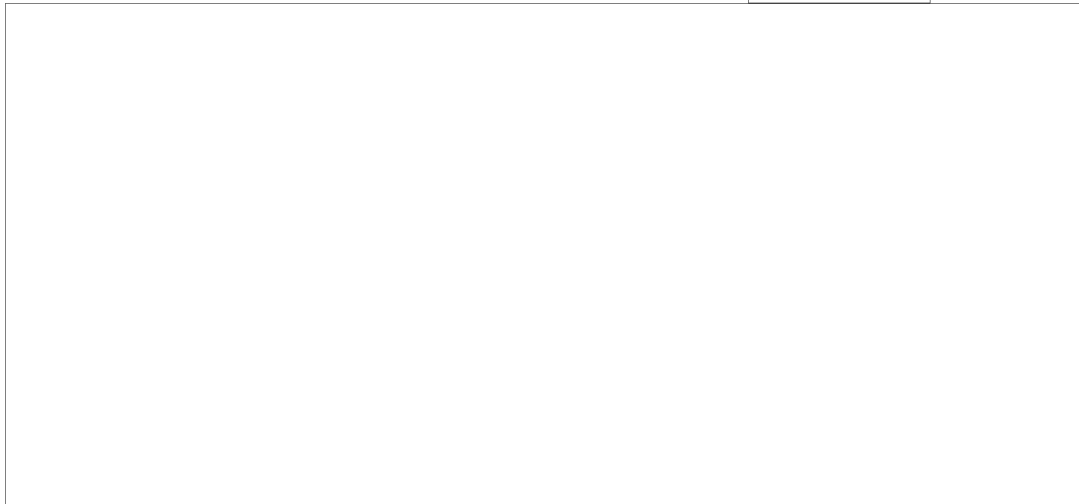
- (1) a tank shuttle-train going from Satz Korn to Wolmirstedt, on the southeastern edge of Letzling Heath, on 24 August 1950. headquarters units of the Fourth Gds Mecz Army observed in the Satz Korn area. The unit possibly was an SP artillery element of the Fourth Gds Mecz Army which went to Letzling Heath possibly for training demonstrations held by elements of the First Gds Mecz Army and the Eighth Gds Army.
- (2) Elements of this division also went to Letzling Heath

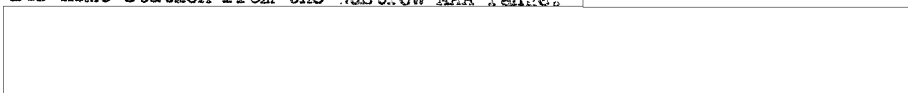
