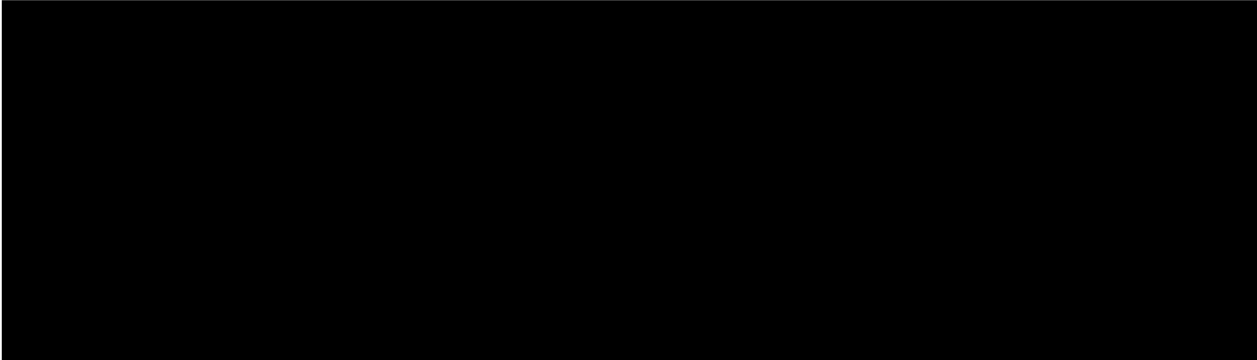

1. The airfield southeast of Zudilkov (27°09'E/50°10'N), Ukrainian SSR, just south of the road to Polonoye (27°31'E/50°07'N), was about 2 km square. It was surrounded by level meadows. No runways or taxiways were seen. Eight to ten gutted barracks buildings were directly beside the road.
2. The field was occupied by 40 to 50 twin-engine planes. *

25X1A * [REDACTED] Comment. This is the first postwar report on the Zudilkov airfield. The field was used as a home base during world war II.
