- 1. The new Chilean Communist publication, <u>Mundo Obrero</u>, scheduled to appear for sale during the first week of November 1950, will be sponsored by the Communist branch of the Confederacion de Trabajadores de Chile (CTCh Comunista). Under the general supervision of Domiciano Soto, acting Secretary General of the CTCh, the magazine will be written by Communist writers and newspapermen. The editorial staff will be headed by Luis Neira (aka Juan Vargas N.) and Luis Corvalan Lepez. Corvalan was the director of the defunct Communist newspaper El Siglo, on which Neira also worked.
- Ihundo Obrero is expected to provide the labor syndicates with Communist-line labor information. In practice and as a source of information on labor, the new magazine will replace Principios which, until it ceased publication in November 1947, was the official organ of the Central Committee of the Communist Party. It is not yet known how frequently Mundo Obrero will appear.
- 3. <u>Nundo Obrero</u>'s editorial office will be at Calle Santo Domingo 1312, which is also the office of Democracia, the Communist newspaper. The two publications are both printed at the Pacifico printing press at Calle Pacifico 2436.
