- The Soviets assigned a daily quota of 10 trains to the Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63)-Brest Litovsk line. However, because of the shortage of locomotives at Frankfurt/Oder only up to eight trains can be dispatched each day. Even those trains are accepted by the Poles only under pressure by the Soviet RTO at Frankfurt/Oder. Poles explain this attitude by the fact that their lines are overburdened and adequate passing and parking facilities are not available. \*

\* Comment. The 8 or 10 trains seem to be only freight trains since a total of 10 to 13 trains daily cross the border at Frankfurt/Oder. The Frankfurt/Oder-Brest Litovsk express train and the two leave trains from Frankfurt/Oder to Brest-Litovsk are included in the latter number.
