- The units from the Pasewalk (N 54/Q 61) barracks installation left between 6 and 9 a.m. on 21 September 1950. The leading passenger cars were equipped with antennae; the supply vehicles were loaded and the troops carried field equipment. Only a rear detail remained in the billeting area. A German worker employed in the barracks said that the troops would return in eight days.
