A telegram dated 29 June 1950 from the Schwerin regional railroad headquarters to the Directorate General states that work on the reconstruction of the dismantled Sanitz (N 55/P 01) - Bad Suelze (N 55/P 22) line cannot be started before 1956 in spite of all insistence by the interested local agencies. This is explained by the facts that there are more urgent construction projects within the framework of the current five-year plan; there is a shortage of money and materials; the line is unprofitable; and there is a bus connection along this line. \*

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- \* [REDACTED] Comment. The Sanitz-Bad Suelze single-track railroad line, 25-km long, was dismantled in 1946. Traffic is now maintained by eight buses. The reconstruction of the line would have only local importance.
