1. The following units of the 24th Air Army have been confirmed at their previous locations:
 - a. One fighter regiment each at Alt-Lönnewitz, Zerbst, Grossenhain, Brandis, Lärz, Finow, Neubrandenburg, Brandenburg, and Peenemünde.
 - b. One ground-attack regiment at Schönwalde.
 - c. One bomber regiment at Finsterwalde.
2. A ground-attack regiment was newly observed at K8then. This is believed to be a regiment which has been temporarily stationed at Stendal, and which may now have been re-transferred to K8then.
3. The following is a summary of the principal units of the 24th Air Army:
