- 25X1 1. At 6:30 a.m. on 28 October 1950, [redacted] a west-bound convoy of 100 to 120 trucks carrying Soviet troops was observed on the highway from Brest Litovsk. AT guns, mortars and AA guns were included in the convoy. [redacted]

- 25X1 2. [redacted] similar movements of motorized Soviet troops had been observed on the preceding three days. **
3. A train of gondola cars and flatcars, 90 axles, shipment record No 135/0266, loaded with eight snow plows and with transformers, left Frankfurt/Oder (O 53/V 63) at 10:30 p.m. on 26 October 1950 and arrived in Brest Litovsk at 1 a.m. on 29 October 1950. **
4. A train of 20 sealed refrigerator cars, 80 axles, bound for Berlin, left Brest Litovsk at 5 a.m. on 29 October 1950 and arrived in Frankfurt/Oder at 5 a.m. on 31 October 1950.
- 25X1 5. [redacted] from Frankfurt/Oder to Brest Litovsk during [redacted] did not see any Soviet troop trains.
