On 1 November PAN Tzu-nien (潘梓年), brother of PAN Han-nien and head of the Education Department of the South China Sub-Bureau, accompanied by SUN Jen-yun (孫仁達), an official of the Sub-Bureau, arrived in Macao. They stayed with K'O Lin, head of the office of the Chinese Communist Special Commissioner for Macao.
- 2. On 6 November FANG Fang, a secretary of the Sub-Bureau and KUANG Ch'un-ch'ih (廣方 方法), its Political Director also arrived in Macao. K'O Lin called a meeting at his office to plan to further the Communist anti-American program. This meeting was attended by PAN, SUN, CH'EN Man and leaders of business and labor organizations in Macao.
- 3. Following the meeting FANG went to Shihch'i (113-22, 22-30) and KUANG remained in Macao.
