25X1 1. The large railroad yard of Malezewice (S 53/M 77), about 1 1/2 km from Brest Litovsk (S 53/M 37), had a large workshop near an old airfield. In October 1950 the field was no longer used by the Soviets. Most of the hangars at the field were demolished. *

[] Comment. The location indicates that the field is the former large airfield of Terespol, which was formerly used by the German Air Force. This is the first postwar information on the field. The report, if correct, is significant because it indicates that the large and formerly well equipped field has not been used since it was destroyed in World War II. The location of the field near the Polish-Russian border may be the reason why it was not used after the war.
