- 5. A Polish signal unit was in a cantonment near \_giorz (Q 52/0 9h) during the period from the spring of 19h8 to June 1950. The cantonment was located on the east side of the Zgierz-Hiala (Q 52/0 95) road, just north of the railroad line and south of a small woods. It is composed of about 10 wooden buildings, each of them about 25 meters long. Six of these buildings appeared to be occupied by personnel. A parking lot for four to six trucks and a signal equipment dump with wire riels and telephone poles were also seen. A German security battalion was quartered in this cantonment during the war. (5) and (6)
- 6. There were an estimated 500 to 600 soldiers quartered in the installation. On several occasions five units, each of company strength, were seen lined up in the cantonment area. The soldiers' age seemed to range up to 20 years. Boside fatigue duties in the cantonment area, work on the Agierz-Piala telephone line was noticed.
- 7. The troops would leave the installation in small detachments of up to 15 men, sometimes with and sometimes without two-wheeled vehicles. The soldiers used to carry signal equipment, such as poles, telephone sets, wire, etc., when without vehicles. They wore fatigue uniforms without insignite.
- 3. Another unoccupied cantonment guarded by a Polish soldier was near the road to Ozorkow (Q 52/0 85) in May 1950. It was rumored among the population that the installation was reserved for Soviet troops, but such troops were not seen. The cantonment was located in a woods about 200 meters west of the road to Ozorkow, about six km from Zgierz. Only three wooden buildings could be seen from the mod. Sections of prefabricated huts were seen arriving at the cantonment in February 1950.
