Reference is made to the increased tempo of current rumors that the Caribbean Legion is about to strike again. Source reports that although Ramirez is now in Guatemala City, he is apparently inactive. The only indication of Legion activities in Guatemala is that two planes of the government-owned Aviateca Airline departed Guatemala City airport at five in the morning, on 30 December 1950, carrying Carlos Castillo Ibarra (Nicaraguan), Jorge Rivas Montes (Honduran), Armando Rodriguez (probably Honduran revolutionary), one Zuniga, and an undetermined number of others. Their destination was not learned by source.
