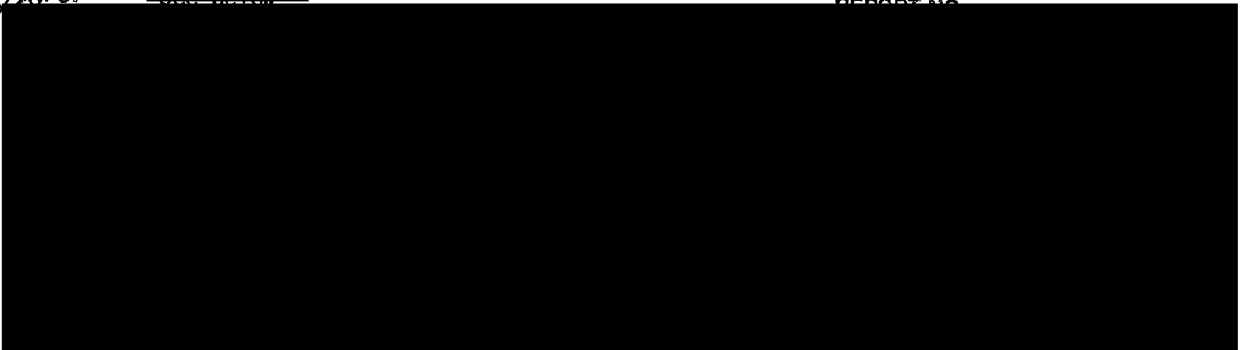

As a result of a joint proposal of General Shtikov, USSR Ambassador to North Korea and Chief of the Soviet advisory group of the Chinese Communist forces in North Korea, and General Derovyanko, the Soviets are discussing with the East Germans a plan to recruit German volunteers from former Nazi Air Force personnel as a nucleus of a Communist international volunteer air force for action in North Korea. The plan is for various Communist Parties to first recruit 1,000 pilots from Party members in non-Communist-controlled areas for training at Chita.
