- In Hay 1950 the Chinese Changchun Railway had four branch offices in addition to the Changchun office. These were in Hukden, Dairen, Harbin, and Chalantun (122-45, 48-01). The chairman of the railway was Lu-ko-ni-chich-fu (長克尼城夫) (? Lukenichev), the vice chairman was LIU Chu-ying (劉尼英).
- The Mukden branch was established on 1 May, at which time the Mukden Ceilway Administration was dissolved. The Mukden branch controls the railway line from Sunghuachiang (125-55, 14-45) to Tachihchiao (122-30, 40-38), a distance of about 300 miles. The director was MAUNC Ching (養 持), deputy director was Tu-la-so-fu (社 技 家夫) (? Tarasov).
- As of 1 May 1950 the Mortheast Special Representative Office of the Ministry of Communications had replaced the Mortheast Railway General Administration. The new office controls the management and administration of railways at Chinchou, Kirin, and Tsitishar.
- In August 1919 employees of the DALVESHTRANS (Balmi Vostochmi Vneshmi Transport) were observed along the Chinese Changchum Railways. This Soviet organization maintained its headquarters in Harbin and had branches at all large stations along the railway. It was particularly active at the border stations of Antung, Mancheuli, Tumen, and Pogranichmik (118-57, 50-35). The mission of DALVESHTPANS was to facilitate the movement of freight and rolling stock to the USSR and to arrange duty-free passage of USCR imports and exports between Manchuria and North Korea.
