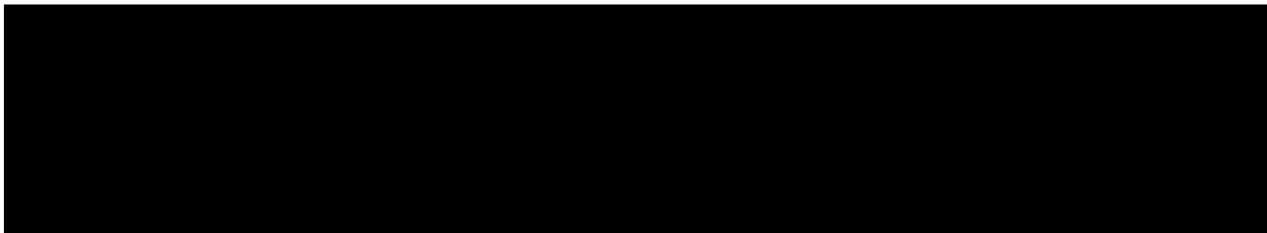

A brigade, consisting of Kosovars and Albanian refugees, has recently been formed in a Yugoslav locality along the Albanian border. The brigade, which is under the command of the Yugoslav Colonel Spasoje Djakovic, is said to be attached to the Yugoslav Regular Army. Captain Shaban Kjalavci, an Albanian, is Assistant Commanding Officer, and Lazar Subotic is the Political Comissar.
