In late December 1950 wounded troops from Korea were arriving at Changchun by rail daily at 10 p.m., at which time martial law was in effect at the station. The troops were removed to the 4 Field Army Hospital (the Southern Manchurian Hospital) at Nanlingtsun (南岭村), two miles south of Changchun, or to the 3 Field Army Hospital at Hsingch'eng (兴城), 66 miles east of Shanhaikuan (sic).* At the first hospital there are 2,800 wounded, at the second 3,200.

[Redacted] Comment. There is a Hsingch'eng at 120-42, 40-38; however, it is northwest of Shanhaikuan.
