- On 21 January 1951 the following units of the 24th Air Army were confirmed as operating at their usual fields:
 - One fighter regiment each at Brandenburg, Oranienburg, and Neubrandenburg.
 - A fighter division headquarters at Peenemünde.
- The units at Brandenburg and Oranienburg practised aerial combat jointly.
- On 22 January the weather was bad, and there was no flying. The following units were observed:
 - A fighter regiment at Neubrandenburg.
 - Fighter division headquarters at Peenemünde.
